About Alankuda

Situated on an undiscovered and deserted two kilometer stretch of a pristine private beach, **Alankuda Beach** offers a truly relaxing, discrete and romantic getaway. The azure, warm ocean is almost always mirror-calm and welcoming. The coastal waters offer the treasures of dolphin and whale watching as well as snorkeling over nearby spectacular coral formations. In addition there is deep-sea fishing, kayaking, canoeing, sailing, kite and wind surfing. **Alankuda Beach** is situated 3 hours north of **Colombo** and just over 2 hours from the airport.

Rooms

Alankuda Beach features a wide range of accommodation from beach cabanas to luxury villas and serves all tastes and preferences.

Cabanas are open sided wattle and daub houses situated in their own 1,000 square meter garden within **Alankuda Beach** and close to the dining **Ambalama** and pool. They have one king-size double bed and two single beds and can comfortably sleep four. Each cabana has its own detached shower and toilet within its fenced garden.

Villas are spacious two bedroom houses with high ceilings and situated in their own 1,000 square meter garden within **Alankuda Beach**. They consist of two double bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms, and a large veranda on which six further single beds can be made. There is an additional bathroom as well, allowing the villa to comfortably host up to ten guests at a time.

Khomba House is the largest house available to rent at **Alankuda** and has two large double bedrooms, a spacious living/lounging area and a kitchen and can sleep up to ten. **Araliya House** is a two bedroom house with a kitchen and living room. It has a double and a twin bedroom with a shared bathroom. **Begonia House** is a breezy cottage with two en-suite double bedrooms and its own secluded seating area and lookout platform for sunsets.

Wooden Cabanas are spacious thatched roof enclosed wooden bedrooms with attached bathrooms and set in a communal garden neighbouring **Alankuda Beach**. They have one king size double bed and one single bed and can comfortably sleep three.

Fine Dining

There is a striking open pavilion restaurant overlooking the **Indian Ocean**, a beach bar and a 40 meter fibre optic-lit pool - all laid out in a whimsical and intriguing mix of the traditional and the new. The food is generous and delicious local fare and the staff are graciously hospitable and unobtrusive.

All rates are on an all-inclusive basis and include meals, drinks, use of the pool, canoeing, kayaking, sailing and cycling. One dolphin and whale watching excursion per day is also included in the rate during the high season.

Excursions

For those who wish to explore the land around them, a visit can be made to the small, nearby town of **Kalpitiya**. It's a vibrant and unspoiled fishing town with an interesting mix of historical buildings from its eventful colonial past.

Adventure watersports such as **Kitesurfing, Wind Surfing, Kayaking** and **Canoeing** are also very popular at **Kalpitiya**.

Diving And Snorkelling

For keen scuba divers and snorkellers, the largest coral reef in **Sri Lanka (Bar Reef)** is only an hour's boat trip from **Kalpitiya**. This beautiful reef is home to an incredible variety of tropical fish as well as offering sighting of **Manta Rays, Reef Sharks** and the occasional **Turtle!**

Dolphin And Whale Watching

The main attraction at **Alankuda Beach** is the rare opportunity to see dolphins and whales in their natural habitat. **Kalpitiya** is one of the best locations in the world for watching **Dolphins**. While pods of **Dolphins** 10-20 strong are almost always encountered a lucky few may encounter 200-300 strong shoals! The **Dolphin** watching season last from **November to April**. You can go out in the early hours of the morning, as the improbably calm sea glitters under the gently rising sun, to search for playful dolphins.

Further out to sea, there are also good possibilities of spotting awe-inspiring whales as the migration corridor of **Blue** and **Sperm Whales** lies in the deep seas off the **Kalpitiya** peninsular.
